Accountancy	✓	✓	Foundation Apprenticeships offer a blended experience combining school, college and work-based learning. Lasting one or two years, pupils typically begin their Foundation Apprenticeship in S5. Young people spend time out of school at college or with a local employer, and complete the Foundation Apprenticeship alongside their other subjects like National 5s and Highers. For two-year courses, the time out of school would typically be two afternoons a week. For one-year courses, the time out of school would typically be two full days. Commitment to travel work beyond scheduled school days are required, as is the courage to work in new contexts, responsibility to keep up with coursework and capability to overtake a demanding Level 6 (Higher-level) course.
